

The EU VAT Reforms

UPS Shipping System Guide

Effective 1 July 2021, there are significant changes to the European Union's Value Added Tax (VAT) rules **impacting B2C shipments to the EU valued up to €150**.

This guide shows you how to enter the new data requirements for these shipments into your UPS shipping system.

Taking these important steps will reduce the risk of border delays and unnecessary import fees.

For B2B shipments or B2C shipments above €150 EUR, you can continue to charge, declare and pay VAT as you do today.

What new shipping data is required from 1 July 2021?

From 1 July, you will be asked to enter an **IOSS number** for **all B2C shipments into the EU valued up to €150**.

If you do not have an IOSS number, you must enter a valid payment account to charge import fees to.

You will no longer have the option of passing on import fees to the receiver.

What is an IOSS number?


The EU has launched an <u>Import-One-Stop-Shop (IOSS) platform</u> to make it easier to settle VAT. It's only for businesses shipping goods valued up to €150 from outside the EU to consumers in the EU.

When you register for this platform you will receive a unique IOSS number.

This IOSS number must be included in the shipping data you provide to us via your UPS shipping system. Failure to do so could result in customs delays and unnecessary import fees.


From 27 June, UPS Internet Shipping will include a field to enter your IOSS number if:

 the shipment is coming from a business outside the EU and destined for a consumer in the EU

and

- 2 the value of the shipment is below or equal to €150.
 - An IOSS number is <u>not</u> required for B2B shipments or B2C shipments above €150.

*The same flow will apply for Enhanced Web Shipping.





How to enter your IOSS number in UPS Internet Shipping

There are three options to enter your IOSS number

1 Complete a form with your IOSS number and email it to us (preferred)

The best way to send it to us is by completing the <u>Power of Attorney for IOSS</u> <u>form</u>, which you can download from <u>ups.com/traderegulation</u>, and emailing it to us at <u>ioss@ups.com</u>. This will allow us to enter your IOSS number into our systems, so it automatically appears when you make an applicable shipment.

2 Save your IOSS number in your UPS.com profile

If you have a profile on UPS.com, you can save your IOSS number there. This will mean we can automatically pre-populate the IOSS number field for your applicable shipments.

How to save your IOSS number in your UPS.com profile

1 Make sure you are logged in. In your UPS.com profile select the IOSS VAT Registration section. Enter your IOSS number. Toggle the Save This Number slider to show Yes. This will allow us to automatically pre-populate your IOSS number for applicable shipments.

2 When you do this, a **Ship Tip** message will appear to give you an overview of the regulatory requirements and where you can learn more.

(i) Ship Tip: When should I provide an IOSS number with my shipment?	
Your IOSS number is useful whenever a shipment involves a VAT charge	levied by a seller when goods were purchased:
$^{\circ}$ If this is not a commercial transaction:	If this shipment is not part of sale of goods to a buyer from a seller, IOSS is not necessary.
$^{\circ}$ If the value of sold goods is more than 150 EUR:	Above this threshold, VAT and other duties are determined on import, so you probably don't need to include your IOSS.
$^{\circ}$ If the value of sold goods is less than 150 EUR:	If you do not provide an IOSS number, the seller or receiver risk additional duties or penalties if customs cannot determine that VAT has already been charged. The shipment may be delayed or (in rare cases) refused.
If the value of sold goods is less than 150 EUR:	penalties if customs cannot determine that VAT has already been charged. The shipment may be delayed or (in rare cases) refused.
^o If the value of sold goods is less than 150 EUR: Note: There is no longer a minimum value threshold for VAT charge on g Learn more about VAT and merchant registration numbers	penalties if customs cannot determine that VAT has already been charged. How to enter your **IOSS number when you** create a shipment

- Under What are you shipping? 1 enter complete and accurate information to ensure we can accurately estimate the duties and taxes.
- Once you have confirmed your 2 payment details, you will be prompted to enter your IOSS number. If you linked it to your UPS account, this field will be prepopulated.

If you do not enter an IOSS number, you will need to enter a valid payment account to charge import fees to.



How to save your IOSS number in your WorldShip profile




How to enter your IOSS number when you create a shipment

1 Enter your IOSS number in the Ship To tab. If you have it linked to your account, this will be pre-populated.

or

- If you select to Bill Transportation and Bill Duty and Tax to Shipper (aka 'Free Domicile') you will not be required to enter an IOSS number.
- If you have not done either step 1 or 2, you will be prompted to confirm if the recipient is a business or a consumer.
- If it's a consumer, you will need to confirm if the shipment value is up to €150. If so, you will be required to do step 1 or 2 in order to proceed.

Host to Host/API

How to enter your IOSS number when you create a shipment

The user interface for both Host to Host and API will depend on the client's customized system preferences.

Until these vendor systems are fully updated to align with the EU VAT reform requirements, please use **Reference Field 3** to enter your IOSS number when you create a shipment.

Appendix

You may be given an IOSS number that looks like this: 'IMDEU1234567'. In this instance, 'DEU' refers to Germany.

However, the European Commission is asking EU countries to use the International Organization for Standardization's (ISO) 3 digit numeric country codes instead for IOSS numbers. So, for Germany it would be '276', so 'IM2761234567.'

Our UPS IT systems support both formats.

For quick reference, here are the 3 digit alpha and numeric country codes for the EU countries.
